You do not have to answer the door to them.

You can make this clear by displaying the other side of this leaflet in your window or door.

If people call and their behaviour worries you, let a neighbour or your Neighbourhood Watch contact know.

If you think there is threat to life or public safety, or that a crime may be in progress dial **999**.

To report a crime other than a crime in progress, call Kent Police on **01622 690 690**.

If you have any information about any crime you can call **Kent Crimestoppers** anonymously on freephone **0800 555 111**.

You may want to think about joining one of our other initiatives such as our **Nominated Neighbour** scheme, which allows you to refer callers to someone who can deal with them.
